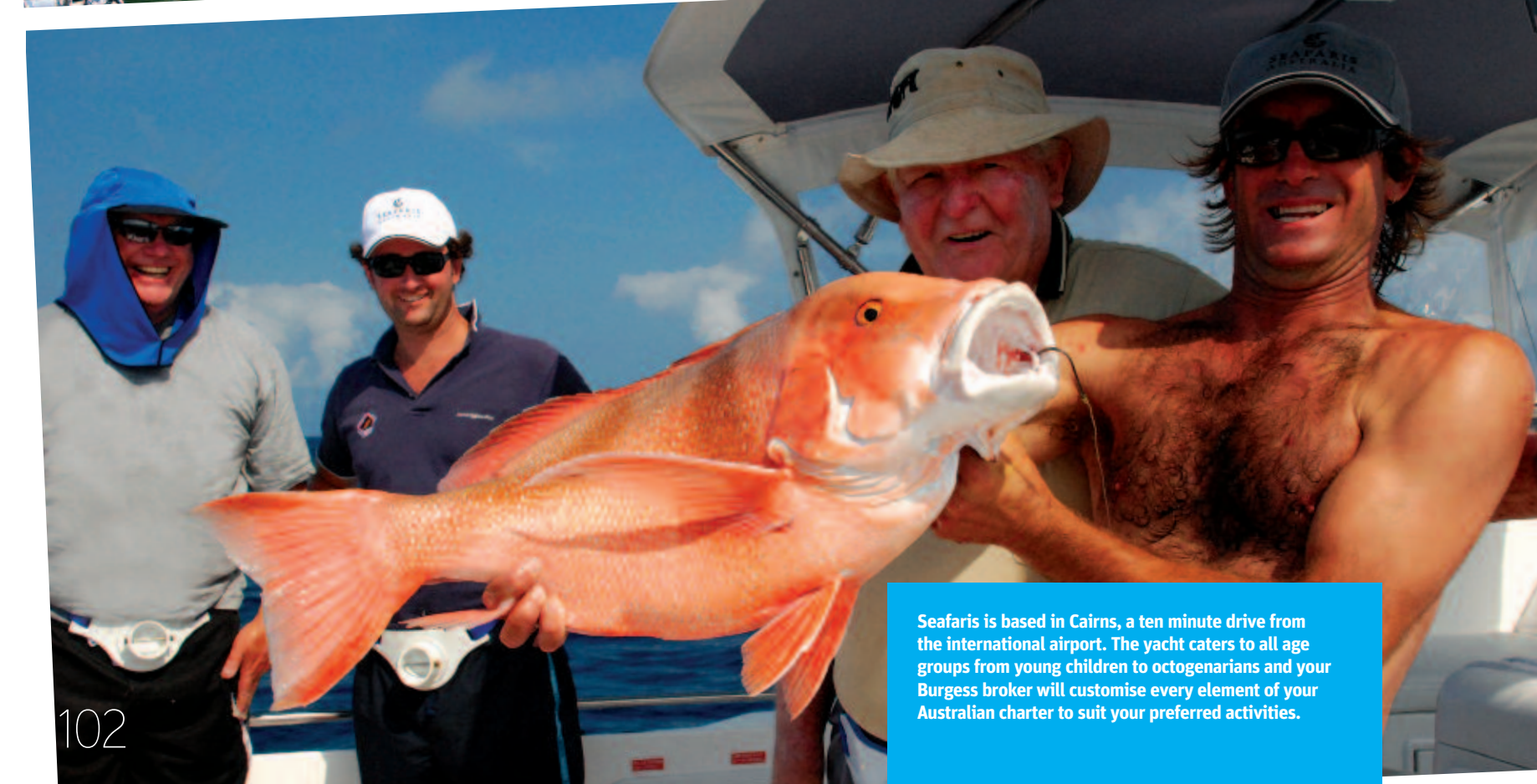

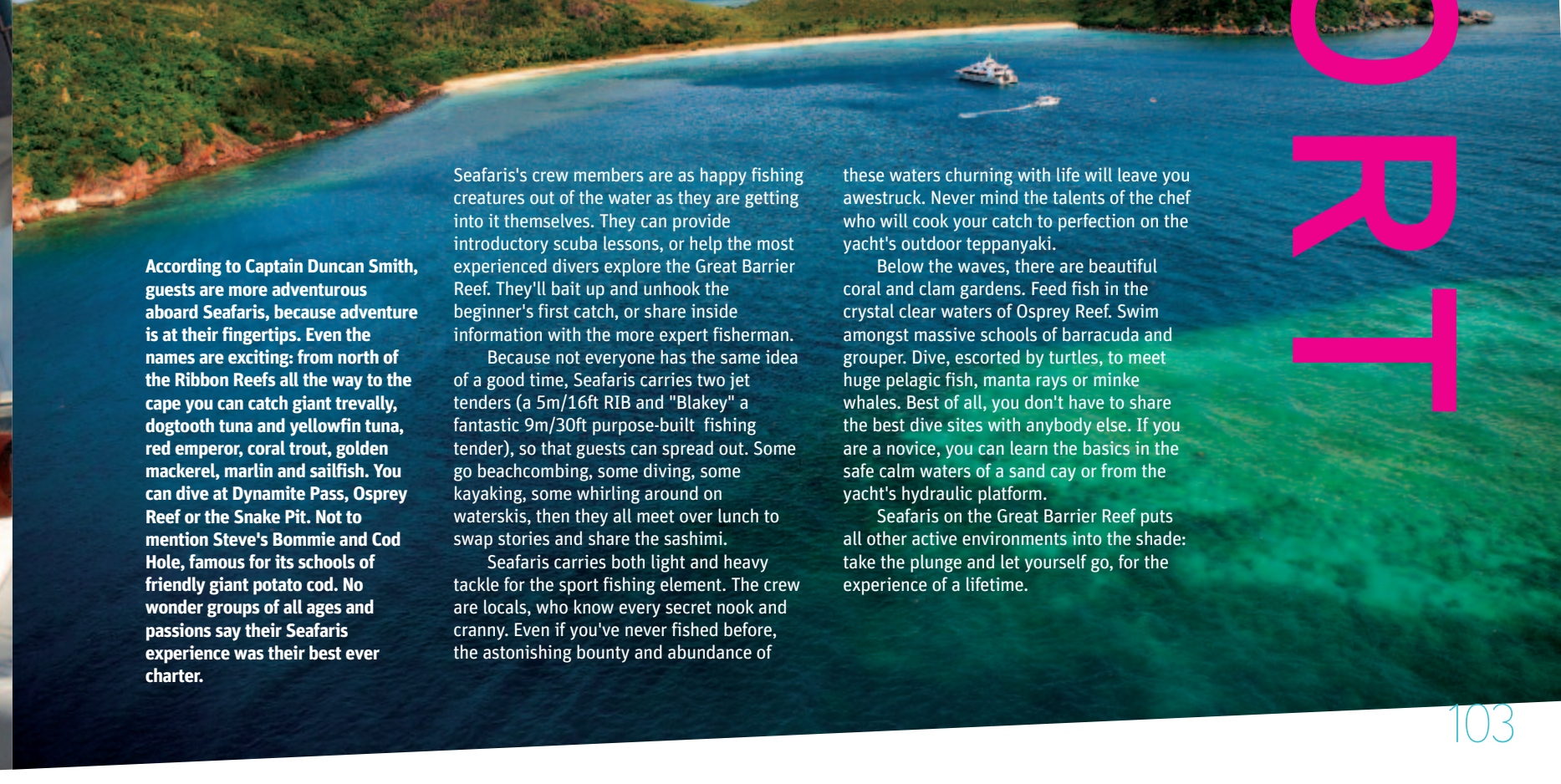

Seafaris is based in Cairns, a ten minute drive from the international airport. The yacht caters to all age groups from young children to octogenarians and your Burgess broker will customise every element of your Australian charter to suit your preferred activities.



According to Captain Duncan Smith, guests are more adventurous aboard Seafaris, because adventure is at their fingertips. Even the names are exciting: from north of the Ribbon Reefs all the way to the cape you can catch giant trevally, dogtooth tuna and yellowfin tuna, red emperor, coral trout, golden mackerel, marlin and sailfish. You can dive at Dynamite Pass, Osprey Reef or the Snake Pit. Not to mention Steve's Bommie and Cod Hole, famous for its schools of friendly giant potato cod. No wonder groups of all ages and passions say their Seafaris experience was their best ever charter.

Seafaris's crew members are as happy fishing creatures out of the water as they are getting into it themselves. They can provide introductory scuba lessons, or help the most experienced divers explore the Great Barrier Reef. They'll bait up and unhook the beginner's first catch, or share inside information with the more expert fisherman.

Because not everyone has the same idea of a good time, Seafaris carries two jet tenders (a 5m/16ft RIB and "Blakey" a fantastic 9m/30ft purpose-built fishing tender), so that guests can spread out. Some go beachcombing, some diving, some kayaking, some whirling around on waterskis, then they all meet over lunch to swap stories and share the sashimi.

Seafaris carries both light and heavy tackle for the sport fishing element. The crew are locals, who know every secret nook and cranny. Even if you've never fished before, the astonishing bounty and abundance of

these waters churning with life will leave you awestruck. Never mind the talents of the chef who will cook your catch to perfection on the yacht's outdoor teppanyaki.

Below the waves, there are beautiful coral and clam gardens. Feed fish in the crystal clear waters of Osprey Reef. Swim amongst massive schools of barracuda and grouper. Dive, escorted by turtles, to meet huge pelagic fish, manta rays or minke whales. Best of all, you don't have to share the best dive sites with anybody else. If you are a novice, you can learn the basics in the safe calm waters of a sand cay or from the yacht's hydraulic platform.

Seafaris on the Great Barrier Reef puts all other active environments into the shade: take the plunge and let yourself go, for the experience of a lifetime.
